On January 6, 2026, Lions from 19 Clubs within East TN District 12N participated in the Operation Inasmuch food packing event held at The Hangar at Pathways Church in Sevierville, TN.

During this event, approximately 40,500 meals consisting of pasta w/tomato sauce were packaged by 81 volunteers working from 9:00 AM to 2:30 PM. Approximately 200 boxes of product were distributed to the Lions Clubs who participated, which were later donated to various food banks/pantries throughout the East TN area.
