The District 12N DG Team has partnered with "Operation Inasmuch" and scheduled a food packing project on Tuesday, December 8th in an attempt to provide **ALL DISTRICT 12N CLUBS** an opportunity to serve their communities this holiday season. This project is **FREE** to all 12N clubs! We will be packaging 40,000 meals of Mac and Cheese and Rice and Beans. **Mask wearing is mandatory**. "Operation Inasmuch" provides all hair nets, gloves, and products. On-site training will take place on how to do each stage of the packing process. **Each club will be eligible to receive approx. 4.5 boxes of food or 972 meals**. Each box contains 36 meal packets that will feed up to a family of 6.

To make this project a success, we will need **volunteer help** (individuals who feel safe to participate) and a **Club Commitment** to have someone pick up the club's share of boxes on Tuesday, December 8th no later than 4:30 PM to distribute however the club deems appropriate (individuals, church and community food banks, Domestic Violence Shelters, etc). **There will be 2 shifts (1:00 PM – 3:00 PM and 3:00 PM – 5:00 PM).** Choose one or both. No outside food or beverage may be brought in.
